In submitting an entry the Artist contracts with Red Hill consolidated School & acknowledges acceptance of the following conditions -

Submission & Entry Process

The submission & entry procedure will follow these stages

- Initial submission is made online at <https://artredhill.submittable.com> , with a Submission fee of \$40 (non-refundable) payable at the time of submission
- After the closing date, all submissions will be assessed by the ARH Selection Panel
- Artists whose works are successful will be notified & invited to exhibit at the 2017 show. A return email from the artist will be required to confirm their acceptance
- The Panels decision is final & no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- Submissions will only be accepted via the online portal & no late submissions will be accepted.
- Please be aware that this art show is held as a major fundraiser for Red Hill Consolidated School & as such, children will be in attendance at the show & also led through in class groups as part of our cultural development. As such, works not suitable for children's viewing will not be selected for the show.

1. Submission Fee

- a. The Submission fees for items/artist is below
- b. Submission fees are payable at the time of submission - this does not guarantee selection, this is an administrative fee to be considered for the show. No further fees are required if successful.
- c. All submissions must be new & original works completed by the artist. Previously submitted items may not be entered. If works to be submitted are unfinished, work of a similar style & representative of the artist can be included with clear notation that it is not the actual piece being submitted. The ARH committee reserves the right to decline any piece that arrives at the show that does not fit with the style of the work submitted.

2. Closing Date for Submissions and Fees

- b. Closing date for submissions is Sunday 19th March 2017
- c. Late entries will not be accepted

3. Delivery Date for Artworks

- a. Artworks are to be delivered to the School Gymnasium;
Painting, Photography & Works on Paper categories
Wednesday 26 April (10pm - 4pm) & **Saturday 29 April** (10am - 2pm)
Textiles, glass, ceramics categories
Saturday 29 April (10am - 2pm)
Jewellery category
Saturday 29 April (10am - 2pm), **Wednesday 3 May** (12pm - 4pm)
Sculpture category
Saturday 29 April (10am - 2pm), **Wednesday 3 May** (12pm - 4pm), **Thursday 4 May** * (12pm - 4pm)
- b. Each artwork must be clearly labelled with the artist, the title and the price and ready to hang - hanging works - stretched canvas is acceptable but must have rigid & adequate cross members. Each work must be fitted with substantial hanging wire or heavy duty cord & "flush D hangers". The apex of the hanging wire or cord should be approx. 75mm below the top of the frame - artwork without secure hanging fixtures cannot be hung. * Large sculpture works delivered on Wednesday 3 May & Thursday 4 May will be placed in the outdoor sculpture exhibition.

4. Complimentary Pass

- a. Each exhibitor is entitled to **one complimentary pass** to Art Red Hill including the opening night and the general admission period
- b. Additional tickets for the opening night are \$30.00 per person (\$25 if purchased online)
- c. Additional tickets for the general admission period are \$5.00 per person

5. Collection of Unsold Artworks

- a. Unsold artworks must be collected between 4.30pm and 7.30pm on Sunday 7 May 2017
- b. **NO EARLY COLLECTION** of unsold artworks is possible
- c. Agents collecting unsold artworks on behalf of an artist must provide written authorisation
- d. Art Red Hill takes no responsibility for unsold artworks remaining after the scheduled collection period

6. Payment for Sold Artworks

- a. Art Red Hill will deduct a commission of 30% of the selling price of each artwork sold
- b. Any artist without an ABN is required to submit a "Statement by Supplier" attached below // <https://www.ato.gov.au/uploadedFiles/Content/MEI/downloads/Statement%20by%20a%20supplier.pdf> - otherwise the full tax rate will be applied to the payment.
- b. A cheque or if provided an EFT to a nominated bank account for the remaining amount will be forwarded to the artist no later than Friday 2 June 2017

7. General Conditions

- 7.1 The artist covenants that :
 - a. all artworks provided by the artist shall be original, suitably framed or finished and ready for hanging or display and where appropriate, shall be provided with materials and in a condition to facilitate hanging/presentation.
 - b. the Artist acknowledges having been requested by these Conditions of Entry to take out appropriate insurance for their works .
 - c. Artists will assume all risks associated with their artwork at the event.
- 7.2 Accordingly artworks shall be exhibited solely at the artist's own risk
- 7.3 Art Red Hill shall use its reasonable best endeavours to take care of artworks whilst within its custody or control but relies on the covenant of the artist that the artist will have their works appropriately insured.
- 7.4. Art Red Hill reserves the right to refuse to display an artwork for reason that it is not delivered within the required time frame, is too large or heavy, is not delivered in a condition which is easy to hang or present or which in the absolute discretion of Art Red Hill is visually offensive or otherwise inappropriate.
